Sequester is Beginning to take Toll on Industry April 25, 2013

The U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has informed the airlines that, beginning this Sunday, April 28, 2013, it intends to furlough air traffic controllers and related FAA employees as part of the federal government's budget sequestration. Further, the FAA has advised these sequestration-related furloughs will likely have a significant impact on operations at all airlines, resulting in major delays across the nation's air traffic system. Industry-wide, the FAA's plan could delay one out of every three people who fly every day, and the delays could be lengthy.

The FAA expects to delay more than 6,700 daily flights by implementing ground-delay programs or other traffic management initiatives every single day, including limiting the number of aircraft operations per hour. Put another way, the FAA's plan is to create more than double the delays experienced in the worst day last year, and to do it every single day.

We need all of our members reaching out to their Congressman to let them know that the sequester could very well put you out of business. LANJ will send out a sheet with the members of the NJ delegation's phone numbers.

Chauffeur Training Certification Moving Forward April 25, 2013
