

## **GBTA Urges Customer Education on TNC Coverage Gap**

Take heed! The Global Business Travel Association (GBTA) has issued a blog post on <a href="https://www.gbta.org">www.gbta.org</a> that urges customer education on the transportation network company (TNC) coverage gap.

Citing an exposure that puts businesses and travelers at risk, the blog provides GBTA survey data which indicates only 29% of companies "have made thoughtful decisions about whether (TNC) services are appropriate for their employees."

Of these, just "five percent of companies have made INCs their preferred ground transportation alternative, while 24% have policies specifically prohibiting their use."

This, the blog explains, "leaves approximately 71% of companies where TNCs are an acceptable option, but while these companies are reimbursing employees who use TNCs, many may have informal, ad hoc or no policies in place regarding TNCs. That creates a glaring gap that puts businesses and travelers at risk."

"Businesses should do their due diligence, determine what's right for their company and put a formal policy in place," concludes Mike McCormick, GBTA executive director and author of the blog post.
