

As presented by Ralph Bitter of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection at the March 16 LANJ meeting, following are **some** of the Garden State's idling regulations that warrant \$250-\$1,000 fines for vehicle owners if not heeded:

NO - Do NOT Idle...

* For more than three minutes under most circumstances.

* A bus, for more than 15 consecutive minutes in a 60 minute period while **actively** discharging or picking up passengers.

* Diesel: For more than 15 consecutive minutes when the vehicle has been stopped for three or more hours and only if the temperature is less than 25 degrees F.




