LANJ Engages New Lobbyist Michael DeLamater

Michael DeLamater, chief executive officer and president of the lobbying and political consulting firm **Market Street Strategies**, has been engaged by the Limousine Association of New Jersey (LANJ) to represent the organization in Trenton.

DeLamater started working in politics in 2010. From 2011 to 2013 he was legislative aide for Connie Wagner (D-Paramus) and Tim Eustace (D-Maywood). He then went on to serve as legislative director to State Sen. Joseph Lagana (D-Paramus) where he worked on one of the nation's first transportation network company (TNC) regulatory laws. He served as a senior advisor to Governor Murphy's 2017 campaign before joining the governor's office as director of intergovernmental affairs and where he later assumed the position of deputy chief of staff.

Says LANJ president **Jason Sharenow**: "Mike will be a tremendous asset to the lobbying efforts of our association. He hit the ground running with the New York City congestion pricing issue and is knee-deep in it now."
