LANJ Donates \$10,000 to Covenant House NJ and Police Unity Tour

trafficked youth between the ages of 18-21. Today there are 30 Covenant House locations in the U.S.A., Canada and Latin America. Together they serve more than 51,000 homeless young people each year. Covenant House is the nation's largest privately funded agency serving homeless, runaway and at-risk youth. Its doors are open 24 hours a day for youth in need.

In addition to the Covenant House donation and for the second year in a row, the Limousine Association of New Jersey on September 17 also presented representatives of the **Police Unity Tour** with a check for \$5,000, a portion of the 2nd Annual LANJ Golf Outing's proceeds.

The primary purpose of the Police Unity Tour, which was founded by an officer in the Florham Park Police Department and now has grown into nine chapters with nearly 2,500 members nationwide, is to raise awareness of law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty. The organization's secondary purpose is to raise funds for the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial and Museum in Washington, D.C.
